### **Exchange 2003 Server and Exchange 2003 Hosting**

At the same time this platform ensures that your company data is available at all times and despite the increased amount of work processes, this data remains safe from illegitimate access.



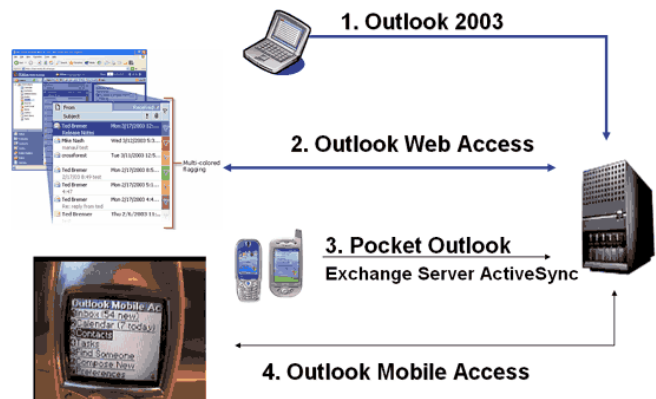
Many companies do not have the resources to ensure the data's safety and the reliable administration of the system. As an alternative MicronNexus offers the option of server hosting through its partner IP Hamburg. In this scenario the Exchange Server is connected directly with the internet within the IPHH IT-centre. You can then accede the Exchange Server any way you like and the entire administration of the system is performed by MicronNexus technicians.

## Access at any time from various platforms

You can accede your data on the Exchange 2003 from the outside with any possible client: with MS Office, a web browser, mobile phones or Handheld PCs (PDA)

Client access to the Exchange Server:

- Outlook Web Access via HTTP/HTTPS
- Outlook Mobile Access for WAP (I-Mode)
- Outlook Mobile Access for PDA
- Exchange Server Active Sync for pocket PC 2002/2003
- POP3/IMAP-4
- Outlook direct access via MAPI
- Outlook direct access via HTTP (MAPI over HTTP tunnelling with Outlook 2003 only)



## Working offline

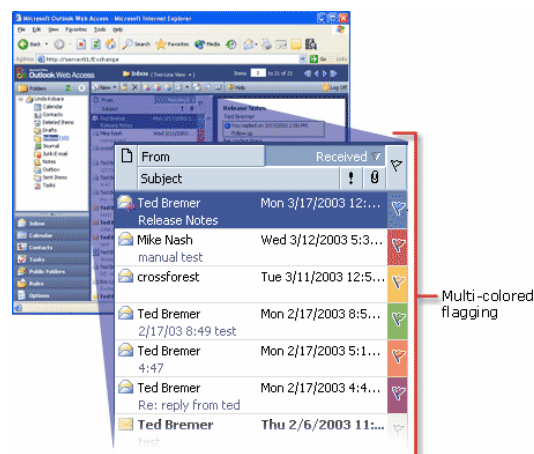
Microsoft Outlook offers the possibility of synchronising a local version of the data stored on the server (E-Mails, addresses and appointments). This provides a current version of your data to all the co-workers – independently from an Internet access or the company network. In addition the data is constantly saved by means of an automatic backup.

## Public folders

The organisation of the public folders works Similarly to the management of the calendar, the contacts, the tasks and the E-Mail messagery in the mailbox. Individual (zugangsrechte) can be set here. Address books can be updated centrally or general appointments can be made accessible to all users.

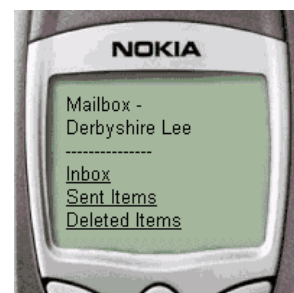
## Outlook Web Access

Your Outlook is not available for mailbox access when you are not in the office. When you are travelling and you would like to check your E-Mails by means of an internet terminal at the hotel or at the airport, you can always accede to your mailbox with any available web browser. Whether you want to look up an address, check on an appointment or just write an E-Mail, Outlook Web Access is the tool that makes it all possible.



## Outlook Mobile Access with WAP

Modern mobile phones are usually equipped with an integrated WAP access which can also be used to reach the Outlook Web Access. This allows you to read and answer E-Mails i.e. from inside a taxi.



## Outlook Mobile Access for PDAs

Many PDAs are currently equipped with internet access via GSM or WLAN. Because of the limitation of their bandwidth and the size of their display, there is a special access in order to provide optimal performance.

## Exchange Server ActiveSync

Any user of a pocket PC knows the problem: synchronising the pocket PC is only possible with an office based docking station, which is impossible when out of office. ActiveSync now allows you the synchronisation through the internet. This ensures that all current data is available on your PDA at any time.



## **Server based rules**

Rules can be defined both within Outlook and on the server. As an example you can easily set an SMS notification for incoming E-Mails.
